At Ashfield Junior School we aim to safeguard and promote our pupils' welfare, safety and health. The children will be guided by fostering an open, honest, caring and supportive climate. The pupils' welfare and well-being are of paramount importance.

We believe in involving the children in decision making in school. This includes activities within the curriculum, personal and social education and emotional aspects of learning.

If a child communicates something that contradicts or conflicts with the parents/carers account of their health or welfare, then we all have clear duty of care to ensure that any discrepancies are properly investigated and explained.

We will make any referrals necessary in line with Working Together to Safeguard Children, HM Government 2015, to ensure all children are safeguarded.

Roles and Responsibilities

Staff in school are in a good position to keep a watchful eye on children and their safety and to protect them from harm. If any member of staff have any concerns they have a duty to inform a member of Ashfield Junior School Safeguarding team -
