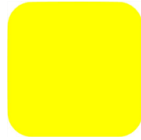
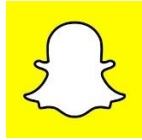

'Starting the Conversation'

Will you ***know*** who your child is talking to,
or gaming with online this summer??



Whatever the age of your children, it's important to keep them safe when browsing websites, using social networking services, gaming and chatting with friends online.

Don't get alarmed by the Internet - Just keep up to date with current advice

Handy hints for safe internet use:

- Ask your children to tell you about the sites they like to visit and ask why.
- Check what is the age limits for the websites or apps they are using.
- Ask them about how they stay safe online. What tips do they have for you? Have you talked to your child about what is OK and not OK to share online?
- Ask them if they know where to go for help if they are unhappy about what they are seeing or experiencing online.
- Think about how you use the internet. What more can your family do to stay safe and have fun when using the internet together?

Parenting Nurturing Programme

What is the Nurturing Programme?

Children are rewarding, stimulating and fun, but looking after them can be stressful and challenging. The Nurturing Programme helps deal with those challenges so you have a calmer, happier family life. A tried and tested programme, it helps us think about what we do, why we do it and how it makes us feel. Partners are welcome to attend and it's also fine if you want to come along on your own or with a relative or a friend.

What does it cover?

Over the 11-week Programme, you will look at lots of different topics including:

- **Understanding why children behave as they do.**
- **Recognising the feelings behind behaviour (ours and theirs).**
- **Exploring different approaches to discipline.**
- **Finding ways to develop co-operation and self-discipline in children.**
- **The importance of looking after ourselves.**
