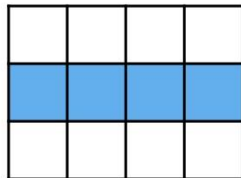
1 Ron has these digit cards.

2 Circle all the fractions that are greater than 1 but less than 2

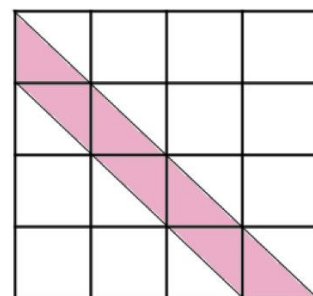

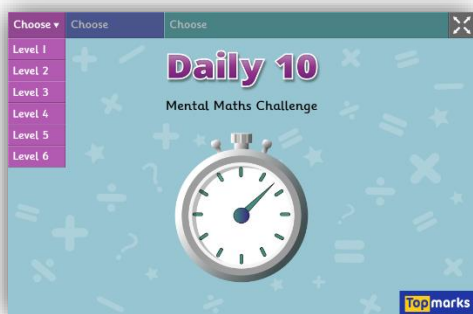
Take a virtual tour through the National Gallery. Stop for a picnic if needed!

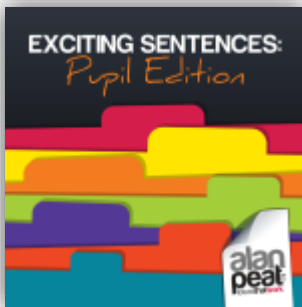
