2. Use your knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to calculate the following:

Practise:

1. $12562 + 17265$
2. $10726 - 5287$
3. 135×7
4. $138 \div 6 =$

Use & Apply:

1. $17823 - \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = 6253$
2. $\underline{\hspace{2cm}} \times 6 = 384$
3. $15 \times 10 = 100 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
4. $240 \div 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}} \times 6$
5. Beth and Mabel share £410 between them. Beth received £100 more than Mabel. How much did Mabel receive?
6. Anna got £268 for her birthday. Ted received £165. What is the difference between the 2 amounts?

Reasoning:

My answer is 5,398. What's the question? Create 3 addition calculations and 3 subtraction questions.

This is your last topic lesson of the half-term. After the half-term our topic subjects of rivers, canals, habitats, animals, life cycles and so on will change. My word, you've packed a lot in. I don't know about you, but I've learnt lots of new things as I've been preparing the lessons.

Task:
