Our initial work will be centred around the children's well-being alongside the assessment of any gaps in learning so that we can support the children to make good progress. At the moment support staff have not been assigned to particular classes until we can assess the need throughout school. Pupils with EHCPs will continue to receive the support outlined in their plans.
