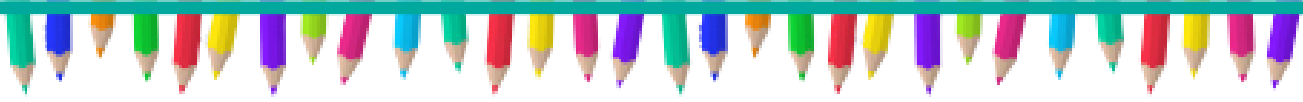


Question Time!
