There is also a Tangram Animals Booklet for you to follow. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book, book from home or Oxford Reading Buddy Book. Don't forget to take the quiz afterwards! Following this, ask your child to summarise the events from the chapter. They could bullet point what happened, create a comic strip or present the information in their own creative way. Encourage your child to note down any unfamiliar words from the chapter they have read. Explore the meanings of these words by using a dictionary, reading around the sentence or using print conventions. Challenge your child to read something around the house that isn't a book. Audible has thousands of children's books for free for your child to enjoy.
