Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Read the story in the 'Journey to Space' booklet and complete some of the activities in the booklet relating to it. It may take you a few days to do this and you might not be able to get everything done- don't worry!
- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or book from home.
- Following this, ask your child to summarise the events from the chapter. They could bullet point what happened, create a comic strip or present the information in their own creative way.

They provide the astronaut with air to breathe, keep them warm or cool, protect from debris flying through space, allow the astronaut to move fairly freely and even have rocket boosters in case the astronaut gets into trouble! Use your work book or the template in resources to design your suit. ZAP! Ask an adult if you can download the Zap code on a mobile or tablet to have a photo taken with Tim Peake!
