- Art C Create your own 3D Constellations. You can do this using cocktail sticks or spaghetti
 and marshmallows or clay or playdough etc... (if you use marshmallows you can eat them
 after, but take a picture first!). Poster of different constellations here
- D+T/ Life skills Design your own space suit! Watch the film clip for ideas. Space suits have lots of different jobs to do. They provide the astronaut with air to breathe, keep them warm or cool, protect from debris flying through space, allow the astronaut to move fairly freely and even have rocket boosters in case the astronaut gets into trouble! Use your work book or the template in resources to design your suit. ZAP! Ask an adult if you can download the Zap code on a mobile or tablet to have a photo taken with Tim Peake!
