<u>Literacy</u>

Who is the main character in the story detective dog?

Can you draw a picture of him and write down some describing words next to your picture that describe the appearance (what he looks like) of Detective Dog.

<u>Phonics and Handwriting</u> is the letter 'i' and the words 'sit, swim, ill, milk and ink'. Try saying these words out loud too!

Numeracy

Before half term we were looking at addition.

Can you order the numicon 1-10.

Get your parents to hide a number, which number have they taken. Play this a few times.

Can you then choose 2 pieces of numicon and add these together, remember to count each circle in the numicon (accurate counting).

Do this until you have added as many different variations as possible.

In our packs you will find a numicon work sheet, can you get the children to make the additions as set out on the sheet. Then write this down beside it, for example 2+1=3.

Make sure your child makes each one then accurately counts these to give the correct answer.

Some of these maybe pretty easy for your child to do (we are just easing ourselves in with some refreshing of what we have been learning so far), if so then write some of your own number addition sentences using the numicon, using the 10 and adding a number, then reversing this such as 10 + 9 = 19, so 9 + 10 = 19.
