An improper fraction is simply when the numerator is larger than the denominator, e.g.  $\frac{7}{5}$

Five divides into 7 once, leaving a remainder of 2.

So we can say that  $\frac{7}{5}$  is equal to 1 whole and  $\frac{2}{5}$ .
