Can you think about what sort of qualities a detective would need to have? Use some adjectives like the examples on the website. Write a few sentences to describe your detective.

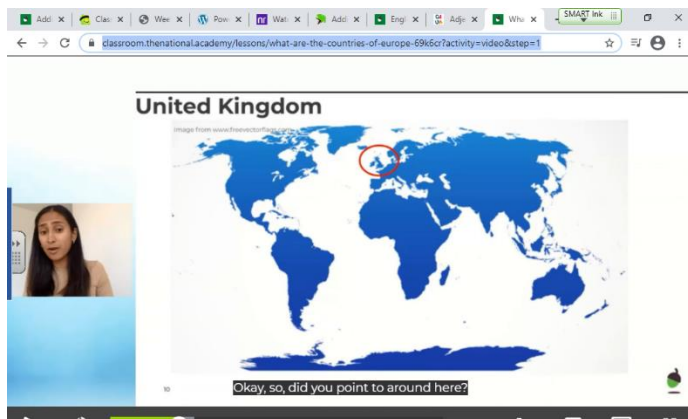


## **ENQUIRY AND INVESTIGATION:**
