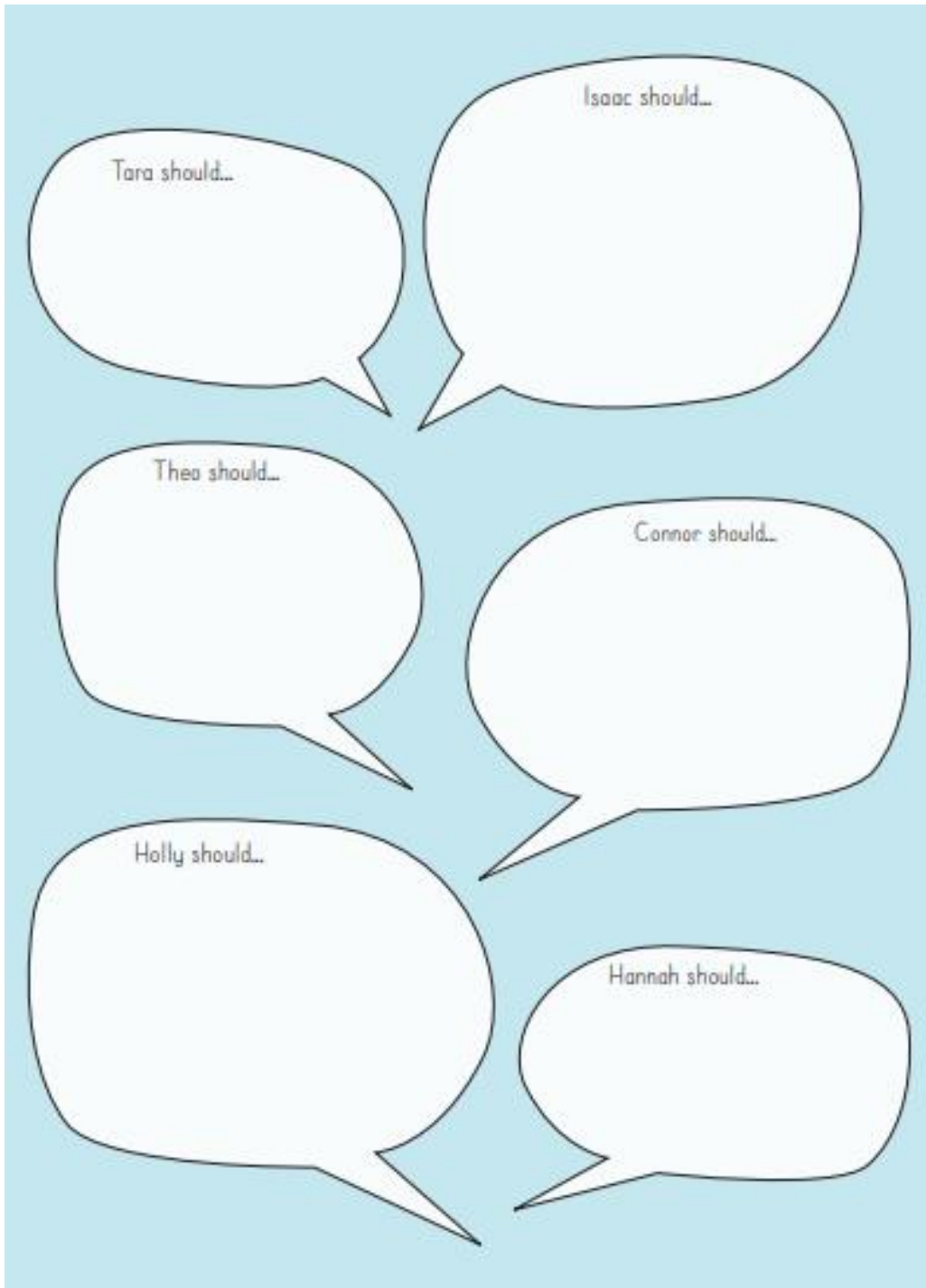

Now think about what would make each child feel better.

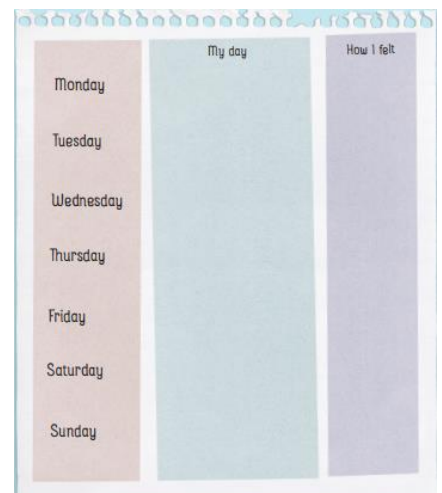


Now – think about how you feel – perhaps think about some different times that you have felt various emotions.

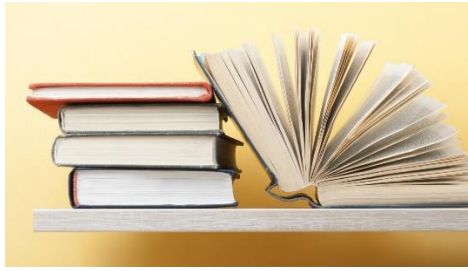
Draw a picture of yourself.

Maths: Dividing by 100.

Think about what you learnt last week with multiplying by 10 and 100. Remember what you learnt yesterday about dividing by 10. This time, we are dividing by 100.

1. Let's remind ourselves how to divide by 10

We already know how to divide some numbers by 10.

$$460 \div 10 = ?$$

Move the digits one place value column to the right.

H	T	O
4	6	0

$$460 \div 10 = 46$$

H	T	O
4	6	0
	4	6

Let's look at how we can divide by 100

$$2700 \div 100 = ?$$

This is the same as dividing by 10, then by 10 again.

Dividing by 10 moves the digits one place value column to the right.

Dividing by 10 again will move the digits another column to the right.

So dividing by 100 must move the digits two place value columns to the right.

Move the digits two columns to the right.

Th	H	T	O
2	7	0	0
		2	7

The zeros in the tens and ones columns are no longer needed.
