Task 1: Watch this video with Mrs Smits:

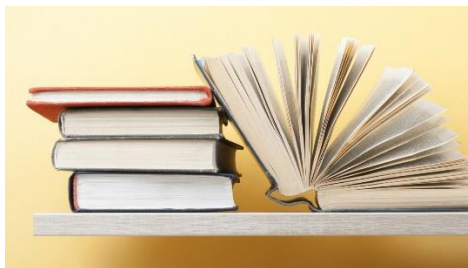
