Don't forget to send us your extreme reading photographs.

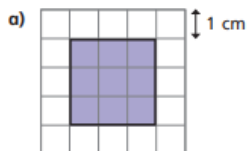

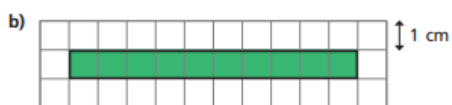

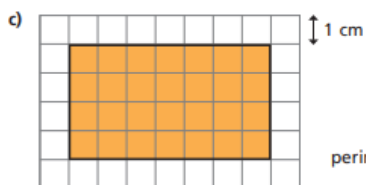
1 Work out the perimeter of each rectangle.

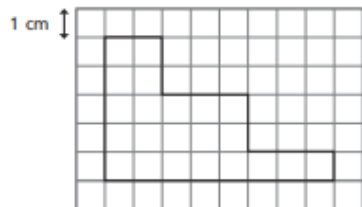

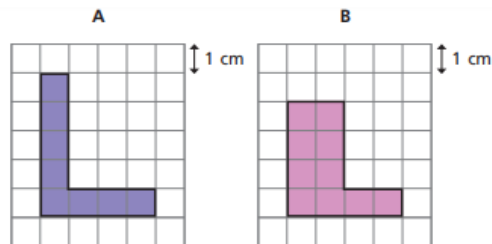
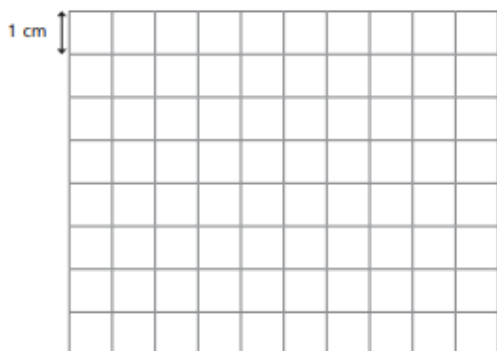

4 Work out the perimeter of the shape.

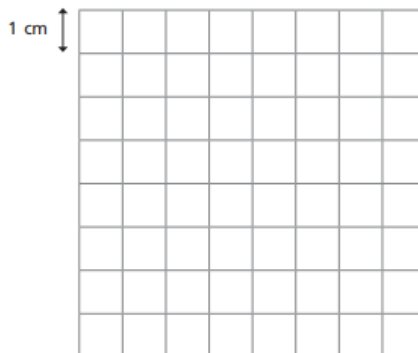


5 Draw two shapes with a perimeter of 20 cm.
Your shapes should **not** be rectangles.

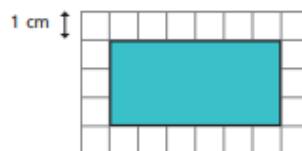


Shape ___ has the greatest perimeter.

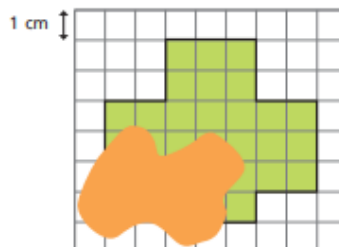
3 Draw two different rectangles with a perimeter of 14 cm.
